


Adding Custom Attributes to Reports

To add a custom attribute from the Lumeta main menu:

1. Select **Reports > Browse Real-Time**.
2. Select a zone and a report (i.e., Zone1 > All Devices).
3. Click an IP on the table and select the **Add Custom Attribute** option.
