

# Adding & Managing Command Centers & Scouts

Standard procedures to add, delete, and upgrade Lumeta components (aka systems) follow.

Upgrade Connected Scouts

1. [Log on](#) to Lumeta.
2. Navigate to **Settings > Lumeta Systems**.
3. Add, delete, or upgrade components, as needed:
  - a. To add a Lumeta Command Center:
    - i. Click **Add System**.
    - ii. Enter the system name or IP address.
    - iii. Click **Add System**.
  - b. To delete a Lumeta Command Center:
    - i. On the **Settings > Lumeta Systems** page, click **Delete System**.
  - c. To upgrade all Scouts connected to your Command Center:
    - i. Check the [Release Notes](#) to your intended upgrade so you'll be apprised of special information concerning the Scout along with a summary of new features, enhancements, fixes, and security updates.
    - ii. Log in to your [FireMon User Center](#) account to access the upgrade. If you need credentials, contact [lumetasupport@firemon.com](mailto:lumetasupport@firemon.com).
    - iii. Navigate to the Downloads page.
    - iv. In the Lumeta panel, click the upgrade package you need and download it to your local system.
    - v. [Log in](#) to a Lumeta Command Center.
    - vi. Browse to **Settings > Lumeta Systems**.
    - vii. In the Available Systems column, select a Command Center.
    - viii. Click **Upgrade Connected Scouts** to upgrade all Scouts connected to it.
      1. Browse to and select the **upgrade tgz** file you downloaded to your local system.
      2. Select the Scouts to upgrade.
    - ix. Click **Submit**.

The upgrade is in progress.
    - x. Validate that the installation completed successfully by browsing to the IP address of your Scouts.

The Scout's new version number should display as intended.
