

BlueCat Plugin Download & Installation

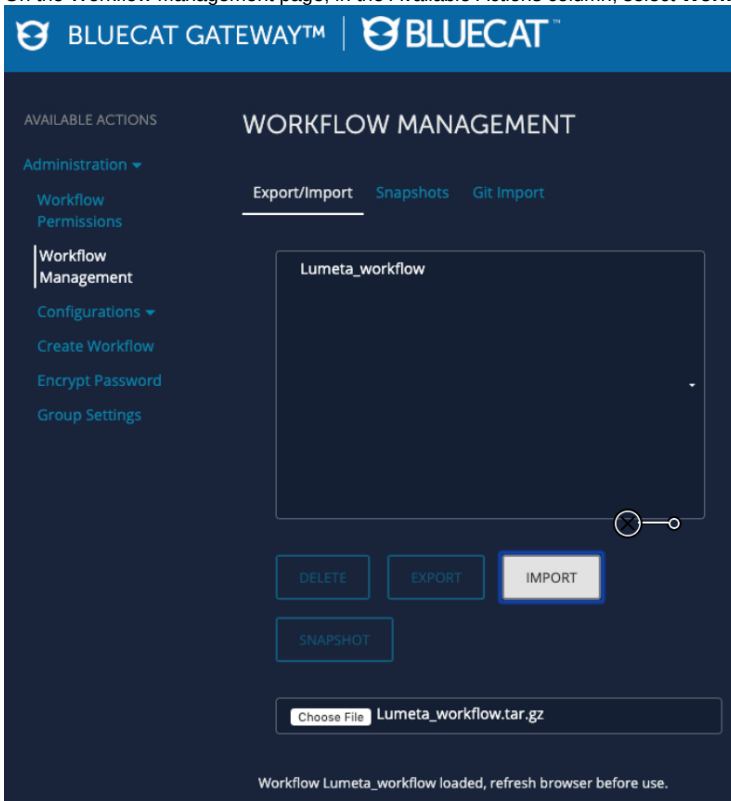
Asset Manager fetches BlueCat-managed addresses, compares them to Asset Manager-discovered addresses within the same network space, and then pushes the differences back to the BlueCat Address Manager. This is done on a continual basis and ensures that BlueCat Address Manager has an authoritative set of IP addresses to manage.

Play this video to learn how to install the plug-in. For the best viewing, expand the player to full screen and in Settings, select Auto 1080p HD as the playback quality.

Installation

Alternatively, you can use the this installation procedure:

1. Speak with your TAM or email support@firemon.com and obtain the Asset Manager Workflow plugin.
2. Save the plugin file to your local directory.
3. Log in to your BlueCat Gateway server.
4. On the Workflow Management page, in the Available Actions column, select **Workflow Management**.



5. At the bottom of the page, select **Choose File**.
6. Browse to and select the workflow file you saved locally, then click **Import**.
7. Select **Lumeta_workflow** and then **Workflow Permissions**.
8. Select **Lumeta_workflow** and then in the Pages section, **Lumeta_workflow_page()**.

9. Add two new group names: **admin** and **all**.
